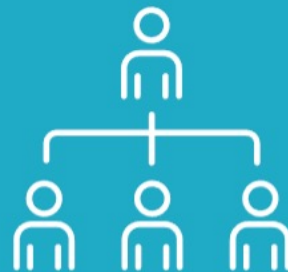

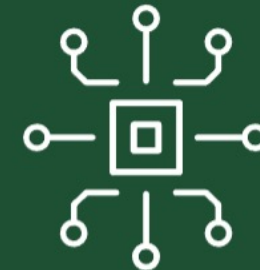

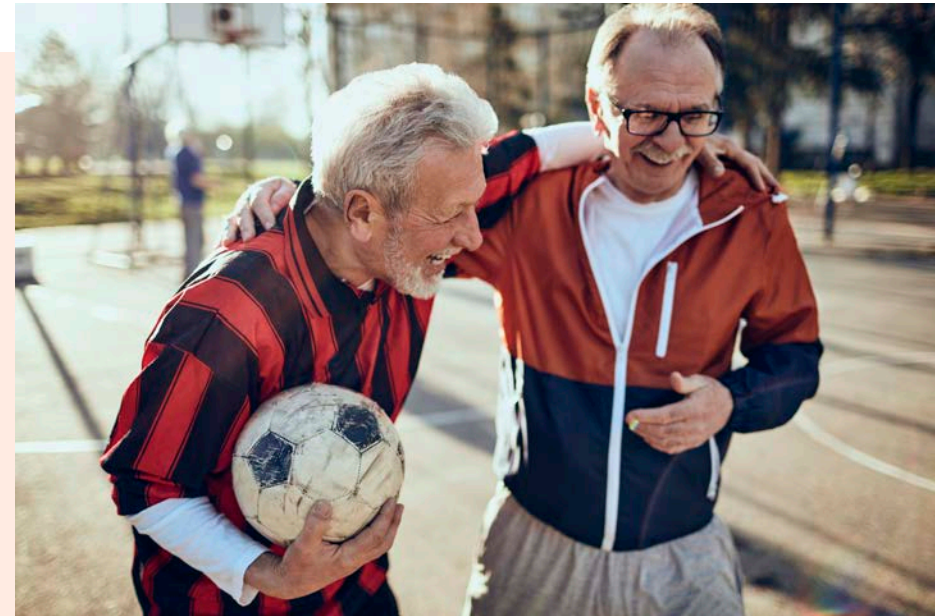

Travel participant: 'Steve'

Haemodialysis patient since young adult
Suffered from social anxiety and was very nervous
Never travelled outside of Sweden, and never experienced holiday dialysis
Previously very defined by his disease, travel brought out a more confident and empowered person in him
Connected with holiday clinic team despite language barrier



Travel participant: 'Eric'

Husband and wife, previously regular travellers

Husband now in dialysis since 3 years

Travel not considered an option due to lack of awareness

Once presented with the option to travel in group, he became hugely excited to resume their life of annual travel experiences

'I can finally feel free enough to enjoy the life I pictured myself doing as a senior citizen'



Travel participant: 'Margot'

Care partner of hemodialysis patient since 1 year
Found herself very lonely in the care partner role
Disconnected from a social support system
Bravely signed herself and her partner up for the group travel, and found a lifelong friend
Continued to travel on their own
